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- **PROFILE OF THE PARTICIPANTS**

We want to welcome a volunteer with relational, creative and dynamic abilities who wants to work as part of a team.

The volunteer will have to be motivated, involved, able to federate other young people, other educational actors around a project.

He or she will have to have a social approach (social skills like sense of listening, respect for confidentiality and approach) and open to proposals.

The practice of the French language will not be indispensable as soon as the young person arrives, provided that has understanding of English.

For the FJT: The volunteer will be asked to have the desire to participate in a project around the kitchen.

For the MJC: The volunteer will be asked to have the desire to participate in a project around photography for the town hall of Tarbes: The young person will have to be motivated, interested in the animation of young people from 11 to 25 years, as well as projects concerning the "support of parenthood. "

- **MISSIONS**

In addition, he/she will have the task of work with the parents of the young people involved in the project "European Exchange: Work in solidarity" in order to obtain their membership and therefore the authorisation for their child to participate in the project and the exchange.

This new project allows us to work on the encounter and the sharing of cultures, the valorisation of the intercultural richness of our territory. It is already impacting our daily actions towards collaborative work targeting European citizenship.

These joint projects will have the ambition to impact the entire agglomeration Tarbaise, working with the various potential partners, namely: all the youth structures, the youth Information Bureau, the FJT, the prevention Association Specialized, all the actors of the "departmental Collective of European mobility"...

In addition to these two half-days, each young person will intervene in his hosting organisation on projects with common objectives with those of the collective project:

- **LE Foyer des Jeunes Travailleurs:**

The purpose of the volunteer will be to assist the team in the programming of socio-cultural and sports activities to the various audiences by promoting the culture meeting.

In connection with another young volunteer on a civic Service mission, he/she will have the task of integrating the project "The Gourmet Toques Intercultural" and to make it live. "Tell me what you eat and I'll tell you who you are." Brillt-Savarion. The kitchen is a great gateway to get to know and better understand other cultures. These cooking workshops will illustrate the intercultural dimensions through the kitchen. The Cooks (volunteers, animators and young people with cooking talents or anecdotes from their countries of origin to be transmitted) explain this cultural reference by anecdotes or knowledge of the country, of its customs.... Participants become aware of their own cultural biases and their ability to adapt. Because the cuisine is universal and singular, it arouses a benevolent curiosity about the notion of difference. Culinary Transmission, forbidden food and religious fact, culinary representations gendered and mixed, kitchens of the world and cultural diversity, these are themes that the volunteer will have to develop but also to work on these own Representations.

We want the volunteer to be able to invest in this project to design it for its interpretation and image, to develop it within our FJT.

- **La MJC d'Aureilhan :**

The volunteer will join the youth team and will be in contact with a coordinator and a youth facilitator on a daily basis see 2 seasonal animators during the holidays.

To meet the objectives set, the ESC will take part in the actions carried out throughout the year.

It will thus be able to integrate our project linked to the photo which allows the young people to express themselves in a citizen way, without taboo or discrimination by attaching great importance to a equality of all and to use the photo as a means of social, cultural mediation and Human.

He/she will take part at the use of image and photo in his country and in France and be a conduit for exchanges and relations on a societal subject concerning the whole of Europe.

The volunteer will also support our team on the Joint Action Project of Aureilhan associations that are working to enable people in difficult neighbourhoods to get involved and participate actively in cultural, educational and Leisure in a convivial setting that promotes the expression of everyone in a free and egalitarian way. This action promotes the weaving of social bonds by the insufflation of a real synergy between the inhabitants themselves and between the inhabitants and the Associations interveners.

The young these will naturally reinforce this notion of cultural and social diversity by being a pragmatic complementary element.

- **Ville de Tarbes:**

In order to work on the commitment, the citizenship, the autonomy of young people and their empowerment, the volunteer will be accompanied by the animation team that will implement a unifying project around European mobility by organizing an European Union exchange on the theme of the Solidarity project. It will be a valuable resource to create a network in its country of origin and to connect the groups of youth and animators

The project's task will be:

- Educate young people about the values of Europe and solidarity.
- To promote socialisation, taking responsibility and empowering young people through involvement and participation in this group project.
- Fostering cultural openness through the discovery of the local heritage of the host country,- fostering dialogue between young people in European countries, through the media which are theirs (social networks, telephone...) and allowing them to meet.
- Promote the exchange of ideas and good practices between professionals,
- Participate in work representing a real interest and added value for the country of origin of the volunteer and for the young people.

To realize this project and its expected young people, in the planning of their activities, will have two half days per week dedicated to the creation of collective projects to feed the individual projects of each structure. It should be noted that these actions can be made in each structure and/or open to partners of the territory to consolidate and ensure their distributions.
